# PARAMEDICS: A PARALLEL MEDICAL SCIENCE

Paramedics can be defined as a practice in the field of medical science that deals with pre-hospital emergency services. A person working in this field is referred to as a Paramedic. In precise Paramedics are healthcare professionals who assist doctors in correct diagnosis and overall care of the patient, and management of the health facilities. Paramedics are - technicians who work hand in hand with doctors and nurses to deliver effective medical care. To be precise a paramedic is a person who is trained to give emergency treatment or assist medical professional for ailment of any patient. A person working in this field must be well acquainted with the medical equipment maintenance procedures, radio-operating procedures as well as emergency vehicle operation. To become a successful paramedic, a person should have the ability to work in rational shifts and should have the presence of mind to take right decision during an emergency.

In countries like the United States and the United Kingdom, paramedics can be usually defined people or workers in the field of medical science that deals with pre-hospital emergencies. However, there are different types of paramedics working in the healthcare sector all over the world like emergency medical technicians, lab technicians, radiology - technicians, optometrists, ECG technicians etc. The requirement for trained professionals is on incredible demand globally where medical services are concerned. Most of the service providers use unskilled workers who learn on the job. This has opened up several career opportunities for young aspirants. Well-trained paramedics are on high demand in hospitals, diagnostic centers, polyclinics, nursing homes, specialty healthcare centers and research



## PROSPECTS AS A PARAMEDIC

After pursuing a course in the field of paramedical science, one can explore various career options available in the medical industry. A paramedic can draw job opportunity in government hospitals, private clinics and trauma centers. Such medical professionals can work as medical lab technicians, radiography technicians, radiologist, pshyotherapist, speech therapist &audiologist, dialysis therapist, emergency technicians, emergency care practitioners, perfusion technicians, cardiac technicians and respiratory therapists. Besides they can opt high-end specialization courses and discover optimum opportunities in India & Aboard.

Like all other medical and Paramedical professionals, Physiotherapist can work in hospitals, orthopedic departments, and schools for mentally retarded and physically disabled children, health institutions and defence medical establishments. In a senior position like senior physiotherapist, supervisor of physical

therapy, superintendent of physiotherapy in government hospitals and as demonstrators, lecturers, assistant and associate professors in medical colleges.

Laboratory Technician may find job in a hospital, minor emergency centers, private laboratories, blood donor's centre, doctor's clinics etc. A technologist can advance to supervisory or management position in Pathology labs and hospitals. They can also work as laboratory manager, consultant or supervisor in healthcare administration.

A recent WHO report, titled a universal truth: NO health without a workforce, says India is one of the 83 countries which miss to match the minimum requirement of having a healthcare workforce of 22.8 per 10000 pupils. The country has only 15.8 skilled health professionals per 10000 pupils. So, it reveals that PARAMEDICS will be required in huge number in near future.

# RAGGING – NO TOLERANCE

BIPS has a “No Tolerance” attitude towards ragging and abides by the Raghavan Commission. According to Supreme Court of India, it is a criminal offence and at our institute it is treated like that too.

Complain with the definition of ragging, the following activities will be treated as an act of Ragging:

- Abetment to ragging.
- Criminal conspiracy of ragging.
- Violation of decency during ragging.
- Unlawful assembly while ragging.
- Injury to body – causing hurt.
- Wrongful confinement.
- Wrongful restraint.
- Use of outsiders- criminal force.
- Criminal intimidation.
- Assault as well as sexual offence.
- Extortion.
- Physical or physiological humiliation.
- Any act that prevents disturbs the regular academic of students.
- All other offences following from the definition of ragging.

Our institute has an anti –ragging committee to restrict such unlawful acts inside college campus. This committee makes sure that no incident of ragging takes place in BIPS and exemplary punishment for the wrong doers. Students can report any kind of ragging activity, incident of harassment or bullying to the committee. BIPS assures strict and fast actions against raggars.

The mobile numbers of the committee members are provided in a notice board inside campus for anytime assistance against any incident of ragging.



## The Hon'ble Supreme Court of India Judgement The Supreme Court of India Order May 2007 (based on Raghavan Committee Recommendations)

We have perused the Report of the Committee constituted pursuant to this Court's order to suggest remedial measures to tackle with the problem of ragging in educational institutions.

An elaborate report has been submitted by the Committee headed by Dr.R.K. Raghavan. According to the Committee, the following factors need to be focused to tackle with the problem.

1. Primary responsibility for curbing ragging rests with academic institutions themselves
2. Ragging adversely impacts the standards of higher education.
3. Incentives should be available to institutions for curbing the menace and there should be disincentives for failure to do so.
4. Enrolment in academic pursuits or a campus life should not immunize any adult citizen from penal provisions of the laws of the land.
5. Ragging needs to be perceived as failure to inculcate human values from the schooling stage.
6. Behavioural patterns among students, particularly potential 'raggers', need to be identified.
7. Measures against ragging must deter its recurrence.
8. Concerted action is required at the level of the school, higher educational institution, district administration, university, State and Central Governments to make any curb effective.

Media and the Civil Society should be involved in this exercise. The Committee has made several recommendations. For the present, we feel that the following recommendations should be implemented without any further lapse of time.

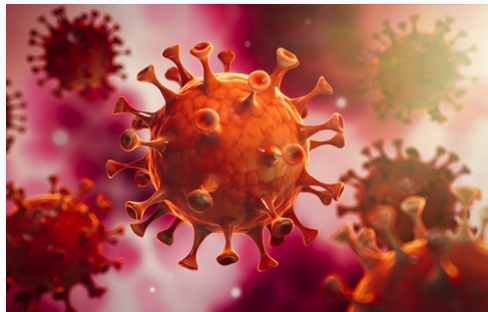

# Covid – 19

Corona viruses are RNA viruses that cause diseases in mammals and birds, In humans, these viruses cause respiratory tract infections that can range from mild to lethal. Mild illnesses include some cases of the common cold (which is also caused by other viruses, predominantly rhinoviruses), while more lethal varieties can cause Severe Acute Respiratory Syndrome (SARS), Middle East Respiratory Syndrome (MERS), and Corona Virus Disease 2019 (COVID-19). These viruses were first discovered in the 1930s when an acute respiratory infection of domesticated chickens was shown to be caused by infectious bronchitis virus (IBV). Human coronaviruses were discovered in the 1960s. They are enveloped viruses with a positive-sense single-stranded RNA genome and a nucleocapsid of helical symmetry. The genome size of coronaviruses ranges from approximately 26 to 32 kilobases, one of the largest among RNA viruses. They have characteristic club shaped spikes that project from their surface, which in electron micrographs create an image reminiscent of the solar corona, from which their name derives Coronavirus disease (COVID-19) is an infectious disease caused by a newly discovered coronavirus called severe acute respiratory syndrome coronavirus 2 (SARS-CoV-2). Since











the first described cases of SARS-CoV-2 were identified in the Hubei region of China in December 2019, Coronavirus has been spreading rapidly across countries. On March 11th 2020, the World Health Organization (WHO) finally declared the SARS-CoV-2 a pandemic due to the increasing number of cases around the world. COVID-19 affects different people in different ways. Most infected

people will develop mild to moderate illness and recover without hospitalization. Most common symptoms are fever, dry cough, tiredness. Less common symptoms are aches and pains, sore throat, diarrhea, conjunctivitis, headache, loss of taste or smell, a rash on skin, or discoloration of fingers or toes.

Serious symptoms are difficulty breathing or shortness of breath, chest pain or pressure, loss of speech or movement. Most people infected with the COVID-19 virus will experience mild to moderate respiratory illness and recover without requiring special treatment. Older people, and those with underlying medical problems like cardiovascular disease, diabetes, chronic respiratory disease, renal diseases and cancer are more likely to develop serious illness. On average it takes 5-6 days from when someone is infected with the virus for symptoms to show, however it can take up to 14 days.

# GENERAL RULES

- Institute's decision for the selection procedure will be final, no complain will be taken on that matter.
- Students enrolled are not permitted to undergo any other courses of study during the course tenure.
- The student will have to attend theory and practical classes as well as the training programs with diligence and sincerity and will maintain discipline at all levels during the course.
- The students will not be allowed to appear in the college exams and university exams unless he/she has attended 75% of the lectures, demonstrations and practical classes as per the University norms.
- Failure to comply with the rules and regulations of the college will lead to disciplinary action such as warning, fines and suspension or even expulsion from the college. In all disciplinary matters, the decision of the management will be final and binding.
- The management of the college reserves the right to change/modify the prospectus, rules, guidelines, fee structure and other criteria of the college whenever necessary according to the situation and will not be answerable to anyone for such changes. Everyone connected to the college shall be bound by these rules and times. Any legal disputes that may arise shall be subjected to the jurisdiction of WB.
- All students are required to carry the college identity card and should wear their uniform within the campus during college hours. The identity card is issued by college after admission.
- All notices issued by the authorities of the college require mandatory reading and strict obedience.
- College fees should always be paid within the stipulated date. However, after the due date, the fees may be paid with a late fee as detailed below:
- Late fee of Rs. 50 /-per day will be charged if not paid within due date. Last date for submission will be 7 days prior to the exam date.
- Late fee for depositing other fees after due date is Rs 25 /- per day. Last date for submission will be 7 days prior to the exam date.
- Students have to clear all the outstanding of the academic year within the stipulated time before the University exam schedule.
- Semester examination fees, internal supplementary exam fees etc. will occur as directed by the college authority from time to time.
- If library card, Identity card is lost then the same can be obtained from the college office by paying a fee of Rs. 50/-.
- Fees once deposited will not be refunded under any circumstances.
- Students should have apolitical view while attending the college.
- Ragging or any activity of such nature is strictly condemned by the authorities. Any student found participating in any activity of that sort would be punished accordingly by the authorities.
- A candidate must complete his/hers 17 years as on 31st December of the academic year of admission.
- Lateral entry allowed for the appropriate candidates as per the university norms.
